The Discovery Zone is an attempt to isolate what your primary motivation and ability (spiritual gift) is for serving in the church. Read each statement that indicates a motivation for serving in the church. Mark one box *only* for each statement. Mark the box that is most true *for you* regarding that statement. You will score yourself on the last page of this document.

Some tips as you begin:

- 1. Don't try to over analyze the question. Just respond.
- 2. Don't try to 'outguess the test.' We are not trying to stump you. We are attempting to guide your praying and thinking. Scoring high in one area of giftedness on this test does NOT guarantee that thing will be your gift. Remember the Holy Spirit determines what gift you have. We are trying to help you listen to Him.
- 3. Many of the questions we ask overlap areas of obedience that all believers are called to. We understand that. Please do not guilt yourself into an answer because you know that is something you should be doing. We want to direct you toward those areas of motivation and the ability that the Holy Spirit gave you.
