Romans 13:1-7 and 1 Peter 2:13-17 are HARD truth! They are 'BIG BOY THEOLOGY'

If you want to know how mature you are in your discipleship, ask: "How do I receive and live out these two difficult passages?"

The Teaching Concerning 'CITIZENSHIP' to Earthly kingdoms is CONSISTENT...

Let every person be in subjection to the governing authorities... - Paul (Rom 13)

Submit yourselves for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether to a king as the one in authority, or to governors... - Peter (1 Peter 2)

Then He said to them, "Then render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's; and to God the things that are God's..." - Jesus (Matt 22)

The Holy Spirit to both Paul (Rom 13) and Peter (1 Peter 2) uses the same word (*hupotasso*) for this act of 'believership' without regard for: Time or Economy

Style of Government or Geography

- Hupotasso does not make 'man' GOD
- Hupotasso simply gives earthly rulers **AUTHORITY** (and RESPONSIBILITY) under God
 - Hupotasso does not mean Christians STAY SILENT

The idea of *hupotasso* is to 'work within' (whatever) the system to: Maximize the **TESTIMONY** of God

FURTHER the Kingdom of God

Improve the **SOCIAL CLIMATE** so it REFLECTS God

The FOCUS is not politics or economics or culture (these are all man-made constructs). The focus is FAITH-BASED CIVICS!

Faith-Based Civics Romans 13; 1 Peter 2

1 Government is **ESTABLISHED** by God...not man! Rom 13:1

We are to **PRAY** 1 Timothy 2:1-3

We are to OBEY 1 Peter 2:13-14

2 When we rebel against government, we are rebelling against **GOD**

"Consequently, he who rebels against the authority is rebelling against what God has instituted..." v2

19 When we resist God, we swim in **CONDEMNATION**

"...and they who have opposed will receive condemnation upon themselves." v2

9 God put government there to **DETER** evil

For rulers are not a cause of fear for good behavior, but for evil. Do you want to have no fear of authority? Do what is good, and you will have praise from the same. v3

6 Government is established for the **COMMON GOOD**

...for it is a minister of God to you for good. v4

6 Government possesses the **SWORD** for a reason

...for it does not bear the sword for nothing; for it is a minister of God, an avenger who brings wrath upon the one who pratices evil. v4

When you do it God's way, you get a **CLEAR CONSCIENCE**

...it is necessary to be in subjection, not only because of

- → If a law/policy commands what God FORBIDS Daniel 3:9-18; Exodus 1:15-20
- → If a law/policy forbids what God **COMMANDS** Acts 4:13-19; 5:27-29
- → If a law/policy clearly violates **NATURAL MORAL LAW OR CONVICTION** ABOUT GOD'S WILL Daniel 6:6-10; Romans 1:19-20
