GETTING GOD'S GUIDANCE



Teach me to do your will, for you are my God! Let your good Spirit lead me on level ground! Psalm 143:10 esv

Jesus had been *crucified*, *risen*, and *ascended*For the first time the Disciples were <u>ALONE</u>
Judas had *UNALIVED* himself

The Jesus-followers had the task of <u>REPLACING</u> him

The Apostolic number had to be *RESTORED* of Matt 19:28; Psalm 109:8

Three Criteria For the Search -

- They were **CHOSEN** by Jesus John 6:70,15:16
- 2 They had to have **ACCOMPANIED** Jesus from the beginning
 - They had to have witnessed **RESURRECTED JESUS**

Two Candidates Emerged: Joseph Barsabbas (Justus)

MATTHIAS

Critical Decisions Made them Need to Get God's Guidance

What if they made the wrong choice... Judas had already been a **BUST**!

How will this affect the **FUTURE** of the movement?

What is the effect on the group **DYNAMIC**? Will this **endanger** them?

23 And they proposed two: Joseph called Barsabas, who was surnamed Justus, and Matthias. 24 And they prayed and said, "You, O Lord, who know the hearts of all, show which of these two You have chosen 25 to take part in this ministry and apostleship from which Judas by transgression fell, that he might go to his own place." 26 And they cast their lots, and the lot fell on Matthias. And he was numbered with the eleven apostles.

Acts 1:23-26 nkj

HOW TO GET GOD'S GUIDANCE

Start With this Truth: GOD'S WILL IS NOT A SECRET!

#1 REALIZE WHAT THE DECISION IS REALLY ABOUT

For the disciples, this decision was about the <u>FILLING OUT</u> the role of the *APOSTLE* in God's plan of redemption

ALL OF OUR LIFE DECISIONS MATTER!

- How does what you do next affect <u>ETERNITY</u>?
- How are you **VALUING** and **VIEWING** God's **place** in your life?

I determined to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified.



1 Corinthians 2:2 Series: Acts

#2 ASK THIS: WHAT KIND OF DECISION DO I NEED TO MAKE?

Does this fall under the <u>REVEALED</u> or the <u>CONCEALED</u> will of God?

REVEALED WILL - What has God shown us in the *pages of scripture*CONCEALED WILL - What do we <u>DISCERN</u> from God's *principles* and God's *permission*?

#3 THERE ARE SOME THINGS THAT ARE ALWAYS GOD'S WILL

He wants people to trust Him for <u>SALVATION</u> 2 Peter 3:9; Matt 18:14

He wants you <u>CONTROLLED BY THE SPIRIT</u> Ephesians 5:18

He wants you <u>DEDICATED</u> and <u>COMMITTED</u> to Him 1 Thessalonians 4:3-7

He wants you to be <u>COOPERATIVE</u> rather than <u>REBELLIOUS</u> 1 Peter 2:13-15

He wants you <u>BEARING UP</u> under <u>suffering</u> 1 Peter 3:17-18; 4:19; 5:10

He wants you to know and express <u>GRATITUDE</u> 1 Thessalonians 5:18

He wants you <u>doing</u> the <u>ONE ANOTHERS</u> John 13:34; Ephesians 4:31-32

DOES MY DECISION FALL INTO ONE OF THESE AREAS? #4 UNDERSTAND GOD'S CONCEALED WILL IN LIGHT OF GOD'S REVEALED WILL!

Trust the Bible as your AUTHORITY v16

GUIDELINES V AUTHORITY

- FILTER life through the Bible! vv17-20
- Use the Bible as your <u>TEMPLATE</u> w21-23 DO WHAT IT SAYS

Will this **GLORIFY GOD?** 1 Cor 10:31

Would **JESUS** pursue this action? 1 John 2:6

Will this advance Jesus' TESTIMONY? 1 cor 10:32-33

What **EXAMPLE** does this establish? 1 cor 8:9

Does this **ENCROACH** of Jesus' Lordship in my life? Rom 14:2-8

Do I have to **EXCUSE** this to do it? 1 Peter 2:16

Is this spiritually **PROFITABLE**? 1 Cor 6:12

Does this **BUILD UP**? 1 cor 10:23

Does this create an **ENCUMBRANCE**? Heb 12:1, 1 Cor 9:24-27

Will this try to *CONTROL* me? 1 cor 6:12

- 1 COLLECT all the data/facts/information you need w21-22
- **2 PRAY** it through... vv24-25
- 3 TRUST God's sovereignty to lead you...go with what He says v26

Delight yourself in the LORD and he will give you the desires of your heart. Psalm 37:4

If God is generating the desires, we must allow Him to apply circumstances to those desires to steer them
