THF LIFE Notes

4-12-26

1. Ephesus was a thriving hub of trade, ideas, and cultural influence—much like major cities today. As Paul boldly shared the Good News in the synagogue and beyond, what stands out to you about *how* he engaged such a diverse and influential culture? In what ways is Acts 18:9-20 **descriptive** of what Paul did in a unique setting, and in what ways might it be **prescriptive** for how we share the Gospel in our own “cultural hubs” today?
2. Paul spent two years intentionally teaching and shaping disciples in the Hall of Tyrannus. What does this teach us about the importance of *consistent, long-term discipleship* rather than quick results? What parts of this example feel **prescriptive** for the church today (things we should prioritize), and which parts might simply be **descriptive** of Paul’s specific situation?
3. Through Paul’s investment in a few, the message spread so widely that “all residents of Asia heard the word of the Lord.” What does this passage reveal about the power of multiplication in ministry? How does knowing this challenge us today?
