The goal of life is not a LONG life, but a FULL life - lived to the glory of Jesus!

WHAT WOULD YOUR FINAL WORDS BE TO THOSE AROUND YOU?

This is the first (and only) text in Luke's history of one of Paul's messages to BELIEVERS !



Paul was hurrying to get to Jerusalem by PENTECOST to observe the holiday and to complete the business of delivering **FINANCIAL AID**

This message to the elders of the Ephesian church came during a **PORT OF CALL** in the town of **Miletus**, 37 miles south of Ephesus

APPLICATIONS AND INSIGHTS

1. 3 words: **INTEGRITY, HUMILITY, COURAGE** - Our culture talks a lot about leadership...but basically leadership is just **INFLUENCE** - so how are you influencing those around you?

2. **WATCH YOURSELF** spiritually

3. **GUARD** the Church

4. **SERVE** sacrificially

5. Make **RELATIONSHIPS** count in the Kingdom

THF LIFENotes

5-3-26

1. Paul points to his own life as a “*a faithful example.*” Where do you see consistency between what you believe and how you live—and where might there be gaps? Who has been a “Paul-like” example in your life, and what specific qualities from them could you intentionally model?
2. In verses 22-27, Paul moves forward despite uncertainty, compelled by the Spirit. What fears or unknowns tend to hold you back from obedience? What would it look like for you to step forward with Spirit-led courage this week, even if the outcome isn’t clear?
3. Paul challenges the leaders to guard themselves and the flock (vv. 28-35), then departs with deep emotion and trust in God (vv. 26-38). If you knew your time of influence in a particular role or relationship was coming to an end, what would you want to emphasize most—and how would you want to be remembered? What does that reveal about how you should live and lead right now?
