READ 1 COR 11:23-28

PAID IN FULL

18 For you know that God paid a ransom to save you from the empty life you inherited from your ancestors. And the ransom he paid was not mere gold or silver. 19 He paid for you with the precious lifeblood of Christ, the sinless, spotless Lamb of God. 20 God chose him for this purpose long before the world began, but now in these final days, he was sent to the earth for all to see. And he did this for you.

1 Peter 1:18-20 nlt

Core Truth:

EVERY PAST SIN - ALL CURRENT SINS - EVEN FUTURE SINS WERE ACCOUNTED AND PAID FOR ON THE CROSS!

There are two Christian practices that picture this: **BAPTISM** and THE LORDS SUPPER

A Distinction: HISTORY IS FULL OF PEOPLE WHO WERE MARTYRED OVER THES DEFINITIONS We refer to both baptism and the Lord's Supper as

ORDINANCES, rather than **SACRAMENTS**

Sacrament - from the idea of sacrifice...[Jesus] continues to make sensible things the **CHANNEL** of that grace by which **CATHOLIC** our lives are elevated and sanctified. In baptism we are **DICTIONARY** born again; in confirmation we grow up to perfect men in **DEFINITION**

Christ..." etc. BASICALLY CLAIMS JESUS CONTINUES TO BE

SACRIFICE IN THE ACT OF THE SACRAMENT

Ordinance - refers to that which is ORDAINED or instituted... outward rites prescribed by Christ to be performed by His Church" ... ordinances are **SYMBOLIC** in nature and neither contain in themselves nor convey to others the

GRACE of God.

Why Not a Sacrament (Sacrifice)?

- → It overlooks the FINISHED work of Jesus on the cross! Heb 7:27
- → It ignores the HIGH PRIESTLY work of Jesus! Heb 9:12
- → It undermines Jesus' NECESSARY HUMANITY ! 1 Cor 15:45-46

For Christ also died for sins once for all, the just for the unjust, in order that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit...

1 Peter 3:18

Jesus is very clear that His instroduction and instruction of the

ordinances are to taken **SPIRITUALLY**!

I am the bread of life; he who comes to Me shall not hunger, and he who believes in

Observing and Celebrating the Lord's Supper as representative of Jesus'

sacrifice recognizes our need for **RIGHTEOUSNESS** is satisfied only in Him

John 6 -

Me shall never thirst.

51 "I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he shall live forever; and the bread also which I shall give for the life of the world is My flesh." ... 54 "He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. 55 "For My flesh is true food, and My blood is true drink...63 "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit and are life.

8 Things the Lord's Supper Does

- 1 It PROCLAIMS the gospel 1 cor 11:26
- 2 It properly recalls the MINISTRY of Jesus 1 cor 11:24-25
- 3 It lets the believer's soul/faith FEAST John 6:35
- 4 It focuses beleivers' attention on the NEW COVENANT Jer 31:31-34

But this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days," declares the LORD, "I will put My law within them, and on their heart I will write it; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. 34 "And they shall not teach again, each man his neighbor and each man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they shall all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them," declares the LORD, "for I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more.

THE NEW COVENANT

- JESUS (John 6:35)

- ✓ God's promise to **FORGIVE** us Matthew 26:28
- ✓ God's promise to INTERNALIZE it within us 2 Cor 3:6
 - ✓ God's promise that we will personally KNOW Him
- ✓ God's promise that we will be **HIS PEOPLE**

Jeremiah 31:33-34

- **5** It calls the believer to **LOVE** the church 1 cor 11:17-22
- 6 It causes the believer to take a good look at his LIFE 1 cor 11:27-29
- 1 It leads the believer to reflect on his PARTICIPATION in the life of Jesus 16 Is not the cup of blessing which we bless a sharing in the blood of Christ? Is not the bread which we break a sharing in the body of Christ? 17 Since there is one bread, we who are many are one body; for we all partake of the one bread. 18 Look at the nation Israel; are not those who eat the sacrifices sharers in the altar? 1 Corinthians 10:16-17
- 8 It looks forward to the **RETURN** of Jesus Matthew 26:29
